
The Union Trust Building

The Trust's administration office resides in this building originally built in 1921.



The Stark Block

Originally built as a hotel in 1889, the office buildings are now renovated and well-suited for productive use.



The Palace Theatre

Opened in 1926 as the Manos Theatre, The Palace is still a stunning, historic entertainment venue to this day. From concerts and comedy, to theatre, dance, family entertainment, and more, The Palace entertains more than 85,000 patrons at 100+ events each year.







Greensburg Garden & Civic Center

Founded in 1969, it is a versatile, multipurpose facility used by more than 90 different organizations annually. Its venue includes an auditorium, a large lawn and lanai, guest space for up to 200, gallery wallspace, and a roof and penthouse area with a spectactular view.



ATTENDANCE AND PATRON DEMOGRAPHICS

Although attendance between 2022 and 2023 was down by 18, it is important to note that this was due in part to a reduction of shows/events occurring at The Palace Theatre. In 2022, The Trust managed 116 events (including private events). In 2023, The Trust managed 98 events. New security charges passed on to venue renters contributed in part to a reduction of local organizations securing space at the theatre.

However, average show attendance increased by 10% in 2023, and The Trust also saw a notable increase in out of county attendance driven in part by some of the tourism grant marketing initiatives in place. In 2023, Allegheny County residents purchased 17,020 tickets, while Cambria and Blair County residents purchased 2,309 tickets. Overall, 46,238 of our target ticket-buyer audience came from outside of the county. That's 61% of our total ticket sales.

NOTE: Visitation numbers were determined by attendance figures at each performance/event through ticket scanning and/or ticket stub counts (via our PatronManager ticketing system).
